## Sometimes people are sick or hurt and have to change their schedule.

When John had a rash a few years ago, he could not go swimming for a few weeks. When he got better, he was able to swim again.



Mom's shoulder is still healing, and she can't ride horses. But, she can do other things.

#### Everyone knows that my schedule will change for a while. They are glad that I will be safe with Eric



# When this is all over, I will get to go back to the gym and Placerita and see John and Aaron and Javen.


I will also be able to go shopping with Kristol and out with Jorge and Lidia.
